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# 1 Introduction and Background

POLICY ANSWERS ("R&I POLICY making, implementation ANd Support in the WEsteRn BalkanS") is a project funded by the European Union's Horizon Europe research and innovation programme under grant agreement No 101058873.

POLICY ANSWERS (supports policy coordination in the Western Balkans and with the EC and the EU. 14 partner organisations, representing network nodes in the region and EU expert organisations, support policy dialogue through formal meetings (such as ministerial and steering platform and ad-hoc policy meetings), monitoring and agenda setting, capacity building and implementation of the EU's Western Balkan Agenda, as well as the alignment of thematic priorities. The project implements regional pilot activities and offers an information hub based on the westernbalkans-infohub.eu online information platform. The partners provide analytical evidence via monitoring and mapping activities of the stakeholder ecosystem, of the implementation of the Western Balkans Agenda and of the Western Balkans' integration into the European Research Area as well as via strategic foresight.

POLICY ANSWERS also allows for tailored and targeted capacity building activities in the Western Balkans as well as regional alignment of priorities in relation to the digital transformation, the green agenda and towards healthy societies. Pilot activities provide learning opportunities on policy and programme level and reach out to final beneficiaries related to improved academia-industry cooperation, researcher mobility, inclusion of youth in policy processes, promotion of research infrastructures and increased innovation skills in all areas.

This activity is placed in the frame of the targeted capacity building activities (Work Package 3 of the project) in ALBANIA (Task 3.1) which is coordinated by





Centre for Social Innovation (ZSI) in cooperation with the National Agency for Research and Innovation (NASRI) as Associated Partner.

Horizon Europe and other EU programmes offer a series of opportunities for SMEs, such as the EIC or the EIT. Furthermore, Albania allocated 100.000 euro to the EUREKA call. EUREKA, COST and other stakeholders are interested in supporting the region in its participation. Albanian stakeholders such as NASRI as NCP for Horizon Europe and EUREKA, SME owners, innovation managers, chambers of commerce as well as stakeholders abroad need to be systematically addressed in order to improve the uptake as the opportunities have so far not been taken up by the Albanian SMEs. There is a lack of awareness on the one hand and implementation capacities on the other side. The pipeline of projects in the SME sector needs to be strengthened.

Thus, more hands-on support for companies to address the opportunities is needed, providing individual guidance e.g. on partner search and proposal preparation.

# 2 Description of the Scope and Purpose of the Service

This call requests the provision of the following services for [repeat title of the service], in detail the following work shall be carried out:

- The service provider shall support matchmaking by exploiting existing services and cooperation platforms (EUREKA Association, EEN, clusters, EIT, COST, EU4TECH, etc.) and developing new guidance with the aim of sparking the submission of joint proposals.
- The service provider shall match Albanian companies with their international peers e.g. in countries eligible to apply for Horizon Europe, EIT, EUREKA, COST to be able to jointly apply for innovation funding. The service provider shall support SMEs who do not have the capacity to actively search cooperation partners in foreign countries
- The service provider shall identify and contact the target group in Albania and to this end cooperate closely with NASRI who supports the identification of the target SMEs. Furthermore, the service provider shall be in touch with chambers of commerce and SME associations to spread the information and offer the specific support.
- The service provider shall identify suitable opportunities for SMEs (e.g. open calls).





- The service provider shall explain partner search possibilities and strategies and explore the potential of the target group.
- The service provider shall identify, propose and eventually support contacting matching partners and organise suitable matchmaking activities (e.g. meetings at events, visits, use international matchmaking activities) with the final objective to develop joint proposals ideas and proposal.
- The service provider shall then explain the processes and support the forming consortia about the requirements for submission and proposal preparation.

The following methodological aspects should be taken into account:

The service provider is expected to suggest the most suitable methodology for successful completion of the assignment. A methodological overview needs to be an integral part of the application.

#### Expected Deliverables

- Work Plan with a list of SME target group with initial plans for suitable opportunities and matches
- SMART outcome: at least 10 companies supported to seek matches out of which at least 6 lead to submissions to the international calls (EIC, EIT, EUREKA, etc.) by October 2023
