1 Introduction and Background

POLICY ANSWERS R&I POLICY making, implementation ANd Support in the WEsteRn BalkanS) is a project funded by the European Union's Horizon Europe research and innovation programme under grant agreement No 101058873.

POLICY ANSWERS (supports policy coordination in the Western Balkans and with the EC and the EU. 14 partner organisations, representing network nodes in the region and EU expert organisations, support policy dialogue through formal meetings (such as ministerial and steering platform and ad-hoc policy meetings), monitoring and agenda setting, capacity building and implementation of the EU's Western Balkan Agenda, as well as the alignment of thematic priorities. The project implements regional pilot activities and offers an information hub based on the westernbalkans-infohub.eu online information platform. The partners provide analytical evidence via monitoring and mapping activities of the stakeholder ecosystem, of the implementation of the Western Balkans Agenda and of the Western Balkans' integration into the European Research Area as well as via strategic foresight.

POLICY ANSWERS also allows for tailored and targeted capacity building activities in the Western Balkans as well as regional alignment of priorities in relation to the digital transformation, the green agenda and towards healthy societies. Pilot activities provide learning opportunities on policy and programme level and reach out to final beneficiaries related to improved academia-industry cooperation, researcher mobility, inclusion of youth in policy processes, promotion of research infrastructures and increased innovation skills in all areas.





This activity aims to provide comprehensive profiles of the WB economies (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo^{*1}, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia) indicating the current situation and policy recommendations for decision makers in the region, addressing the Health policy in the Western Balkans for the health of citizens and for the development of a sustainable economy, with a special reference to e-Health services and strategies for strengthening healthcare and the economic opportunities (Work Package 4 of the project, Tasks 4.3). This call and relevant activities are coordinated by the GSI Helmholtzzentrum fuer Schwerionenforschung GmbH (GSI) in cooperation with all participating partners.

2 Description of the Scope and Purpose of the Service

This call requests the provision of the following services for 'Regional Expert -Support for creation of a Report addressing Health policy in the WBs for the health of citizens and for the development of a sustainable economy', in detail the following work shall be carried out:

- Conduct studies on each economy in the WBs on the framework conditions, considering aspects of national development policies and strategic frameworks which are related to transforming health and care towards an active participation in the Health Union. The studies will include the framework of e-Health services and the aspects related to the digital transformation of health and care, stages of their planning and implementation.
- Create a set of recommendations per WB economy for strengthening the healthcare systems and the economic opportunities (e.g. opportunity to develop a sustainable and health oriented tourism, bringing organic and autochthonous food for health at a highly competitive level in Europe, opportunity and needs for new research infrastructures in Health&Food), emphasizing in particular the best projects and good practises and their impact on society and the economy;
- Share and discuss the initial findings with relevant stakeholders within an event to be organized by POLICY ANSWERS, collect comments and recommendations; Revise the findings based on feedback received.

• Submit a final report with all reference materials which includes chapters for each WB economy, underline recommendations per economy, but also draw out recommendations on regional level.

Methodology

The proposed methodology for the service is:

- Desk research
- Interviews with minimum 12 (twelve) key experts (two interviews per WB economy) and 2 experts from EU member countries representing good practice examples

Selection

The selection will be based on the completeness of the application, corresponding competences of the applicant as well as convincing implementation plan. References will be reviewed additionally. Telephone interviews with suitable candidates can be held between 18 December 2022 and 6 January 2023, if deemed necessary.

The Contractor reserves the right not to place any order. Costs for necessary document preparation by the Applicants to this call for tender will not be reimbursed.





Contracting procedure for Service Provider

The selected expert will be informed until January 20, 2023 on the result of the selection procedure. The service provider will sign an agreement with the Contractor, latest by January 31, 2023. The duration of the contract will last from February 1 until December 31, 2023.

Completion of the Service & Payment

Service will be carried out as outlined under *Indicative Timetable and Milestones*, and considering the quality assurance. 40% of the total sum will be paid in July 2023 as interim payment, upon successful completion of the Milestone 3- Interim report including brief interview results (5-10 pages). If the contract has to be terminated during the service period due to not achieving one or more Milestones and other quality concerns, then the payment will be done only for the completed work, according to the weight indicated for each Milestone.
