From 2009 on, full-time and part-time students in the 3rd year of Entrepreneurship Economics of the <u>VERN University of Applied Sciences</u> may choose <u>the elective subject Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development</u>.

Sustainable development requires a new way of thinking and doing business, including solid levels of information among entrepreneurs and organisations. Students - future entrepreneurs - will familiarise themselves with the responsibilities of the business sector and adopt the methods needed to consider and implement development activities.

The elective subject was developed through cooperation between VERN, the not-for-profit organisation <u>ODRAZ - Sustainable Community Development</u> and <u>OIKON - Institute for Applied Ecology</u>, with a curriculum prepared in line with best practices and modern society requirements.
