- Training on Smart Specialisation Strategies, in the context of the WBC-INCO.NET project, held in Belgrade on 11-12 April 2013;

- Balkan Workshop BW2013 – Beyond the Standard Models, organized by the University of Nis in its capacity of leader of the SEENET-MTP Network (Southeastern European Network in Mathematical and Theoretical Physics), held in Vrnjacka Banja on 25 – 29 April 2013.

Yet different in their scope, both projects witnessed a very good participation from the SEE region, with excellent opportunities for further development of regional projects in the respective fields.
