Widening Countries In Horizon Europe

Widening Countries – countries with low performance in previous Framework Programmes

Widening Member States

Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia

Outermost Regions

French Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Mayotte, Reunion Island and Saint-Martin (France), Azores and Madeira (Portugal), Canary Islands (Spain)

Widening Associated Countries

Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, Morocco, North Macedonia, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey and Ukraine

Advantages of active participation in partnerships

- Participation in the decision making process and influencing the partnership strategy and priorities
- Mutual learning & better understanding of the EP instrument
- Networking opportunity (opportunities for future actions) & strenghtening international collaboration

Most frequent responses

- Developing national strategies and driving new developments in national priorities through participation in the EP
- Strenghtening an organisation's international profile and increasing its international visibility

Challenges facing Widening countries

- Lack of personnel incl. need for experienced staff
- Budgetary issues
- Defining national priorities and alignment of partnership goals with national agendas
- Involvement of national and regional stakeholders
- Lack of success in calls for proposals
- Administrative complexity of the EPs



National instruments supporting Widening countries' participation in the EP

- Support and mentoring for researchers applying for grants in the EP calls provided by National Contact Points, national research funding organisations and administrative staff dealing with EU projects
- (plan to) Use of cohesion funds to support participation in EP calls
- Forum gathering national organisations participating in EPs established to monitor national participation in EPs





Support needed to successfully plan and implement the European Partnership

- Structures needed to support national coordination
- Policy support

Support needed also from the EC

- Additional sources of information, especially on: synergies with the Cohesion Policy (or IPA) funds; financial issues (including in-kind contribution); governance structures and policies
- Financial resources
- Personnel
- Dedicated EC officers

Support needed mostly by Widening Countries

Recommendations

- Enhance administrative structures at research organisations supporting researchers applying for grants
- Support investment in personnel (project mangement skills)
- Further develop structures providing policy support and coordination on the national level
