1 Policy actions

- Federal government: still dealing with "running affairs"
- EUROFED, larger team (NCP) at federal level <u>http://eurofed.stis.fgov.be/</u>
- Brussels Region: new nominations for FP7 groups and NCP's, but still not very clear, all nominations have not yet taken place
- French-speaking Community: new nominations for FP7 groups (PEOPLE, among others) and NCP's, still a bit fuzzy

• Federal government: new law on family reunification (July), very restrictive in its practical/concrete elements, longer delays, separate visas

4 Development of international cooperation and actions on integration into ERA

(e.g. new bilateral/international agreements, memberships, support structures, important international projects, programmes, etc.)

- Federal: launch of several calls for proposals with a funding (20%) for third parties:
 - > IAP's, several other calls pro memori closed (few opportunities left)
 - > Multiannual thematic programs- forthcoming
 - Back to Belgium grants not so much of a mobility action, rather a re-integration initiative, open to all citizens, with conditions
 - Non-EU postdoc fellowships not allowed for associated countries (only Kosovo, as defined by UNSC resolution 1244 of 10 June 1999 is eligible)
- Flemish Authority: Pegasus programme of international mobility, pre- and postdoctoral opportunities, linked to a Flemish university, grants of 1 to 3 years for postdocs, COFUND mechanism, <u>http://www.fwo.be/Pegasus-Marie-Curie-fellowships.aspx</u>
- French-speaking Community/FNRS: forthcoming calls, no specific action
- Walloon Region: <u>http://recherche-technologie.wallonie.be/fr/annonces/toutes-les-annonces/index.html</u> (in French!)
- Brussels Region: forthcoming calls, no specific action
