Europe in a Changing World: Inclusive Societies

- 1) promote smart, sustainable and inclusive growth
- 2) build resilient and inclusive societies in Europe
- 3) strengthen Europe's role as a global actor
- 4) close the research & innovation divide in Europe
- => economics, social sciences

Europe in a Changing World: Innovative Societies

- 5) strengthen the evidence base for the Innovation Union & the European Research Area (ERA)
- explore new forms of innovation, incl. social innovation and creativity
- 7) ensure societal engagement in research and innovation
- 8) promote coherent and effective cooperation with 3rd countries
- => economics, social sciences

Europe in a Changing World: Reflective Societies

- 9) enable richer interpretations of the European past
- 10) better understand contemporary European diversity
- 11) Europe's role in the world (incl. an outside perspective)
- => humanities


place of "Science in Society" not defined yet

Embedding of SSH in Horizon2020



Proposed Approach:

- full integration of SSH into each pillar
- full integration of SSH into each specific objective
- essential element of the activities needed to tackle each societal challenges to enhance their impact



=> true interdisciplinarity requires experts on all levels (topic definition, evaluation, project management)
