Smart Specialisation: A place-based policy approach




Key concept of EC Cohesion Policy for place-based reg. innovation

- National or regional research and innovation strategies
- Setting priorities to build competitive advantage through Entrepreneurial Discovery Process (bottom-up)
- · Better match of R&I strengths to business needs
- Address emerging market opportunities, market niches
- More effective use of EU Structural Funds

EU Regulation 1301/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17/12/2013

As a result...2014-2020: Over 120 Smart Specialisation Strategies, designed and implemented at the national and regional levels in the EU.


Concept of Smart Specialisation (S3)



S3: The Notion of Specialisation

S3 is about developing new specialities based on regional concentration of knowledge, competence and market potentials (dynamic)

S3 is NOT to be understood as a sector specialised or relative to other regions (passive)

SIX NEW FLAGSHIP INITIATIVES TO SUPPORT THE TRANSFORMATION OF THE WESTERN BALKANS

Through six flagship initiatives, the Western Balkans Strategy sets out the EU's unprecedented support to the transformation process in the Western Balkans, targeting specific areas of interest for both the EU and the Western Balkans countries:

INITIATIVE TO STRENGTHEN THE RULE OF LAW

Existing tools, such as detailed action plans, will be expanded to all Western Balkans countries. Assessment of reform implementation will be enhanced, including through new advisory missions. Greater use will be made of leverage provided in the negotiating frameworks with Montenegro and Serbia.

INITIATIVE TO REINFORCE ENGAGEMENT ON SECURITY AND MIGRATION

Reinforced cooperation on fighting organised crime, countering terrorism and violent extremism and on border security and migration management. Europol liaison officers will be posted in the region; Joint Investigation Teams further promoted and status agreements with the European Border and Coast Guard Agency concluded.

INITIATIVE TO ENHANCE SUPPORT FOR SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

This will include expanding the Western Balkans Investment Framework, a significant boost in the provision of guarantees to crowd in private investment, support to start-ups and SMEs and greater trade facilitation. A new reinforced social policies, with increased financial assistance to support the social sector, in particular education and health. Funding under Erasmus+ will be doubled.

INITIATIVE FOR A DIGITAL AGENDA FOR THE WESTERN BALKANS

This will include a roadmap to facilitate lowering roaming costs, support to the deployment of broadband and development of eGovernment, eProcurement, eHealth and digital skills.

INITIATIVE TO INCREASE TRANSPORT AND ENERGY CONNECTIVITY

Within the region and with the EU, including new investment support. More effective use will be made of the Connecting Europe Facility in the Western Balkan countries. The EU's Energy Union should be expanded to the Western Balkans.

INITIATIVE TO SUPPORT RECONCILIATION AND GOOD NEIGHBOURLY RELATIONS


This will include support to transitional justice, missing persons and increased cooperation in education, culture, youth and sport, and expanding the scope of the Regional Youth Cooperation Office. The Western Balkans will be fully associated to the European Year of Cultural Heritage, The EU - Western Balkans Heritage Route will be launched.

Smart Specialisation in the Western Balkans: Current Status




JRC (in cooperation with DG NEAR and DG RTD) supports WB's S3 through:




Studies: Comparative Specialisation Analysis – WB-region vs. EU-28

Temporal evolution of the potential specialisation domains in the Western Balkans 2008-2017 (SIRIS Academic)


