Ideal-ist Partner Search Proves Effective

Ideal-ist provides a powerful platform for coupling international partners for ICT projects. From May to November 2007 124 partner searches were launched relating to the 2nd ICT call and the joint call ICT-Security – 80 of these were finally quality-labelled and distributed in 49 countries worldwide. Most proposers found key partners through Ideal-ist and 54 of the partner searches were finally submitted as a project proposal to the European Commission.

iSURF - Best Proposal in its Objective

The iSURF project was retained for funding in the 1st ICT call and found key partners through Ideal-ist. It will enable collaborative supply chain planning by providing several open source interoperability service utilities such as accessing legacy applications, mediation of exchanged planning data, and an RFID based visibility infrastructure. i-SURF addresses intra-

enterprise collaboration especially across multiple domains. In this way the iSURF interoperability middleware will enable the development of integrated solutions for interenterprise interoperability and collaboration among supply chain partners.

Ideal-ist helps you to find research partners in order to benefit from EU funding – we offer the first quality-labelled international ICT partner search network, part-funded by the European Commission. We support ICT research organisations and companies worldwide to find partners for their project ideas, to join projects or to find services which help to succeed in FP7 – with a special focus on SMEs and newcomers. The Ideal-ist network consists of 49 national partners from EU Member States, Candidate Countries and Associated States, as well as the Western Balkan Countries, Newly Independent States and Mediterranean Countries.

FP7 is the short name for the Seventh Framework Programme for Research and Technological Development of the EU. FP7 funds research in Europe and will run from 2007-2013. ICT research activities will be funded with more than 9 billion EUR and cover strategic priorities in areas of European industrial and technological leadership, such as communication networks, embedded computing, nanoelectronics and technologies for audiovisual content.
