ENERGY INFORMATION DAY

During the celebrations of the European Week in Istria (5th – 10th May 2008), for the Europe Day (9th May), the Region of Istria is organizing an Information Day about energy issues and European funding opportunities in the field of energy.

The event is in collaboration and with the support and participation of: the Valencian Region Delegation in Brussels; the European Commission Executive Agency for Competitiveness and Innovation; the IEE National Contact Point of the Ministry of Economy, Labour and Enterpreneurship - Directorate for Energy and Mining of the Republic of Croatia; the Euro Info Communication Centre of the Croatian Chamber of Economy; the European Projects Association; the Energy Management Agency of Udine; and consulting agencies from Croatia and abroad.

The event will take place the 9th of May 2008 at the Hotel Histria in Pula (Croatia) starting from 9.00am.

The main aim of the event is to improve the information flow about funding opportunities for the energy sector, supporting the process of consortia building and networking among Croatian stakeholders and their European counterparts.

As part of the Energy InfoDay a Project Forum Corner will be held between 14.00 and 15.30.

The Project Forum Corner is an informal environment to discuss project ideas.

The Project Forum Corner (PFC) is a meeting place and networking opportunity for project developers and energy experts at international, national and regional level.

This should result in creative ideas, partner identification and identification of people who will take on the project.

The PFC will be organised in 3 thematic tables inspired by the coming calls for proposal for the FP7, CIP(IEE) and INTERREG programmes.

Any project ideas can be communicated beforehand to the organisers and displayed at the PFC in one of the 3 thematic areas. The participants can then go to whichever theme interests them and begin to discuss. It is foreseen that participants can go to different areas during the time allocated for the PFC.

The PFC will be open for discussions of different project ideas during the afternoon of the event. Practitioners from the energy sector will have the opportunity to meet representatives from local and regional levels in an informal setting to discuss ideas and create further contacts.
